Uniform reminder for next term – please support us.

Looking ahead to next term, a polite reminder that earrings and jewellery are not allowed. If you are having your child's ears pierced, the best time to do this is at the very start of the Summer Holidays so they have chance to settle before school starts. Earrings are not allowed for safety reasons.



Also please can we remind everyone that all long hair must be tied back at all times. Single strings or braids of hair over the children's faces are not allowed and must be tied back. This fashion has crept in during the last term and we now need to remind everyone that all long hair must be tied back.

After the holidays, where children have strings of hair, fabric or braiding over their faces, we will be contacting parents to ask for the hair to be tied back.

Why?

The uniform policy is clear that long hair must be tied back. This ensures fairness and compliance in line with the uniform policy.

Hair over the face is an obvious distraction to learning because it either impedes the child's ability to see things or has to be constantly brushed off the face by hand – which is in itself a distraction from learning. Long hair that is loose is a potential hazard during both playground play and also P.E.

Please help and support the high standards of uniform and safety that this school is well known for. We appreciate your support such a lot. Thank you for your understanding.
