Responsibilities of the school

1. To enable your children to learn and grow in a Catholic community;
2. To fully comply with the school's policies and procedures.
3. To attend appropriate training.
4. To inform the Headteacher of any concerns.
5. To treat all children fairly and with respect (CRC Article 2).
6. To raise children's self-esteem and develop their full potential by offering high quality learning experiences.
7. To maintain high expectations of pupil behaviour and learning.
8. To provide an interesting, relevant and challenging curriculum.
9. To create a safe, stimulating and pleasant environment for learning.
10. To use rules and sanctions clearly and consistently.
11. To be a good role model for behaviour, in both manners and in the teachings of the Catholic faith.
12. To establish effective partnerships with outside agencies and parents so that children can see the key adults in their lives share a common aim.
13. To recognise each child as an individual and to take into account the needs of each child.
14. To praise and reward appropriate behaviour and achievements.

15. To complete safeguarding Record of Concern forms and class incident logs.

Responsibilities of Parents

1. To ensure children attend school regularly and arrive on time each day.
2. To inform school immediately of the reason for any pupil absence.
3. To tell school staff about anything that may affect children's work and well-being at school.
4. To show an interest in all that their child does at school
5. To offer help and support with learning at home, including the completion of homework.
6. To encourage independence and self-discipline in their children
7. To establish good communication with school staff and support the behaviour policy.
8. To encourage respect and good behaviour and to make their children aware of inappropriate behaviour.
9. To work with school staff to address and review any behaviour issues with their children.
10. To have daily discussions with teachers where appropriate to discuss incidents within school.

Responsibilities of Children

St Joseph's School Uniform

Boys

Royal Blue St Joseph's pique polo shirt: either plain Royal Blue jumper or Royal Blue St Joseph's sweat-shirt: grey trousers.
Sensible black shoes.

Girls

Royal Blue St Joseph's pique polo shirt: either plain Royal Blue jumper or Royal Blue St Joseph's sweat-shirt: grey skirt/grey uniform trousers.
Sensible black shoes.

Summer Alternative

Girls

Blue Gingham dress: either plain Royal Blue jumper/cardigan or Royal Blue St Joseph's sweatshirt, OR knee length grey shorts.
Sensible, flat-heel shoes. (no flip-flop sandals)

Boys

Knee length grey shorts, sensible shoes (no flip-flop sandals)

Hair Styles and Nail Varnish

Hair shaving and sculpting (e.g. tram lines, ticks and other shavings) are not allowed. Hairstyles must be smart and neat. Use of gels or styling products should be minimal. For safety reasons all long hair (boys and girls) must be tied back at all times. Highlights, dyeing and colouring of hair is not allowed. Nail varnish is not allowed.

P.E. Kit

All children should have:

Plain black shorts: a plain white T-shirt and a pair of pumps: all kept in a PE bag.
