Understanding the World - ELG15 Technology:

- Children recognise that a range of technology is used in places such as homes and schools.
- They select and use technology for particular purposes.

Explanatory note:

- Through discussion, play and practical application the child demonstrates that he or she knows about technology and its use in his or her life and local environment.
- The child chooses the technological opportunities around him or herself as a tool to enhance and extend his or her learning.
