What are we learning about?

English: Text — Journey to the River Sea

Writing: Character profile, newspaper report, information text, letter, description and a recount. Grammar: relative clauses, adverbs, commas, semicolons, colons and building cohesion with paragraphs. SAT's revision.

Maths: Multiplication, division, geometry, fractions, decimals, percentages, algebra and revision.

P.E. will be taught on Monday afternoons and Friday afternoons.

Spellings: To be tested on Mondays with new spellings being given out.

Brilliant In Britain Week: W/B 27th January

Science: Healthy Bodies — we will learn about food and diet in the past which has contributed to our knowledge of a balanced diet. We will learn about the different food groups, how water and nutrients are transported in the human body. We will also look at how the heart works and the circulatory system.

Evolution and Inheritance — To recognise that living things produce offspring but are not always identical. We will learn how plants and animals adapt to their environment.

Geography: South America — We will learn about the location and countries of South America. The children will understand about the weather and climate of the continent. They will learn about the human geography, and about trade and industry.

History: The Aztecs — The children will find out who the Aztecs were and what an advanced civilisation they were. They will learn how society was organised and their beliefs.

Art: Cityscapes — Children will learn about how to use Pop art techniques and layering to create a 3D cityscapes and be able to replicate cityscape photos using different mediums. They will explore how to create reflections of cityscapes on water and then finally be able to create their own using any media of choice.

DT: Shelters — Children will investigate a range of shelters. They will explore how to join and combine materials and components and find out how to reinforce structures. They will find suitable textiles for the purpose of making a shelter. Children will consider specific designs to construct a shelter.
